Keep people away. Warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. **ACCIDENT** Call the emergency services: Dial 111 Keep bystanders away. Leave and/or avoid entering confined spaces. Eliminate all ignition sources and naked lights. **SPILL OR LEAK** Use non-sparking equipment. Wear overalls, chemical resistant boots and gloves (barrier multilayer, nitrile, neoprene), and safety glasses/goggles. Respiratory protection (with organic vapour cartridge) is required for any spill other than minor. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in a sealable container. Wash affected area with water detergent solution. Absorb washings and place in a sealed container, Dispose of to a suitable landfill. FIRE Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep people away. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide or fine water spray. Cool other containers to prevent rupture. Contain run-off. **FIRST AID** IF SWALLOWED Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor immediately Hold eyes open and rinse with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if easy to do so. For advice call the IF IN EYES National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor immediately. Immediately wash affected area with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Call a Doctor or IF ON SKIN National Poisons Centre for advice if irritation persists. Immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. For advice call the IF INHALED National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor immediately. STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY Storage: Keep out of reach of children. Do not store near heat, flame or other source of ignition. Store in original, tightly closed container, in a secure place away from feed, or foodstuffs. Store in a dry, well-ventilated area avoiding temperatures below -5°C and above 35°C Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with other hazardous substances, the aggregate quantity must be considered.
