<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call emergency services: Dial 111</b>						
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Wear protective clothing (coveralls). Wear disposable latex or similar flexible gloves suitable for biological hazards. Exclude non-essential people from the area. Prevent any further spillage. Sweep up solids without generating dust. Dispose of waste safely in an approved landfill. Report large spills to Emergency Services at 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622)						
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed containers with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.						
<b>FIRST AID</b>							
<b>If Swallowed:</b>	If swallowed, call the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately and show the container/label/safety data sheet. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control centre or doctor.						
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye						
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Remove contaminated clothing. Launder before re-use. Rinse skin immediately with soap and water.						
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Inhalation is not applicable as a route of exposure under normal conditions of use.

<b>Storage:</b> Store in tightly closed original container in a cool, dry well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight when not in use. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, children and animals.
