Wear goggles, respirator, full length chemical resistant overalls (buttoned to neck and wrist), gloves and boots. Sweep up spilled material with inert material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Large spills/leaks: Call emergency services 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622). Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal. Fire Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or CO2. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away. **FIRST AID** DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
