

# **Superphosphate**

# BATCH NUMBER: BAGGING DATE:

Read label carefully and obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Superphosphate is a phosphorus- and sulphur-based fertiliser that is ideal for optimum plant establishment and growth. Both the phosphorus and sulphur are in readily available forms for immediate plant uptake.

## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Prior to planting apply 75-100 grams/ square metre. Maintenance apply 30-45 grams/square metre. Ensure that product is well watered into soil and washed off plant leaves into the soil. It is not recommended for use in potted plants. Avoid fertiliser contacting paths, hard surfaces and driveways as the fertiliser may stain or discolour these surfaces.

#### **COMPONENTS**

Nitrogen (N): 0.0%. Phosphorus (P): 9.0%. Potassium (K): 0.0%. Sulphur (S): 11.0%. Magnesium (Mg): 0.0%. Calcium (Ca): 20.0%.

#### **CONTAINS**

Superphosphate 100%

#### HANDLING PRECUATIONS AND STORAGE

#### **HANDLING**

Avoid generating dusts, do not breathe dusts. If additional safety information is required, refer to the Safety Data Sheet (SDS). For a copy of the SDS phone 0800 100 123.

#### **STORAGE**

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area.

# IF IN EYES
